Planning Your Event in **Dunscore Church**



The Church building was opened in 1823. Built from local whinstone and red sandstone and renovated in 2017, it is used weekly for worship and regularly for community events. It is home to the Dunscore Heritage Centre with exhibits and information on the development of the village and surrounding area, and the lives of some of the famous people associated with the area. The flexible space is equally usable for large concerts and occasions, and smaller, more intimate, gatherings or meetings.



The building has flexible seating for up to 120 people downstairs with a similar number in pews in the balcony if required. A smaller room off the main area provides a quiet space for smaller meetings or breakout groups. Chairs in the main space can be set out as you choose and tables are available too.



There is a full sound system for PA and audio playback (including Bluetooth) and a hearing loop system for those with hearing impairment. We also have the ability to project images and videos if required. A simple kitchen provides opportunities for tea, coffee and other refreshments during your event.

There is full access for all abilities throughout and is designed to cope with the varied needs of users, including toilet facilities and baby-changing.

The car park has plenty of space and the church building is just a few paces away with full access for those who are less able and wheelchairs users.
