Eco - Snippet - Keep it fresh

Most U.K. fridges are set to 7degC but lowering that to 4C could increase the lifespan of your produce by up to three days. This helps prevent food waste and saves money as you won't need to restock your fridge so often. Check use-by and best- before dates on packaging: use-by, always on fresh food, means it will go off after that date and shouldn't be eaten; best-before, on store cupboard foods, for instance, tells you when it is at its peak, but there's no end date because there is less risk to your safety.
