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A Message from our Minister:

Our reading today is a story of ten lepers, healed by Jesus. Leprosy is still a significant disease in many parts of the world and its effects on the individual stir up all sorts of emotions – repulsion, horror, fear, etc. Colonies for separation of the infected still exist!

As with many aspects of life, Jesus challenged taboos and norms. Not just of 'His time', but many which still affect us today – treatment of women, fear of the diseased, ignorance of mental health issues. We don't know how Jesus chose those He healed but we know that race, colour, health were not factors – He was (and is) an equal-opportunity healer.

We are called to follow Him, not just by attending church services, but by living in a way which demonstrates His Love for all, whatever the circumstances or differences we find. As we remember how Jesus is an equal-opportunity Saviour let us be bold in challenging the taboos we hold on to, obvious or hidden. Ask the Holy Spirit to re-set your thinking in these areas to His Way.

We are also called to be grateful – thank God for His many blessings in **ALL** situations. Have an attitude of gratitude! Only the unlikely Leper came back to say "thank You". 
