A Message from our Minister:

ALLELUIA! Christ is Risen!

He is Risen indeed! ALLELUIA!

Today is the end of Christian Aid week and the Sunday after Ascension Day.

Jesus' Ascension did not stop the outpouring of New Life which began on that first Easter Day, but opened the way for a new phase of His work – the bit that involves us, with the aid of the Holy Spirit. His Disciples were challenged to "stop staring into the heavens" and move on to the job of sharing the Good News in a world full of chaos and uncertainty.

Ring any bells?

It's great to sing the amazing hymns and songs, hear the comforting Scriptures, and feel God's Presence in our worship, but that is not the 'be-all and end-all' of faith! Like the first disciples, we are called to respond by going out into our lives carrying Jesus and His Love and Grace. The Holy Spirit uses our worship to re-fill and re-fuel us for the days ahead, overfilling us so that the Love and Grace we receive from God simply **must** spill out as we move through life. What the Risen, Ascended Jesus gives us is not to be hidden away, cradled in our arms to avoid any spillage, but is intended to slop around us through the ups and downs that we face, to splash Love and Grace onto those we meet who need them.

Having said all that, why not invite some of those friends and neighbours to meet with Jesus for themselves by joining us in worship. In Communion (next Sunday at Dunscore, 4th June at St Ninian's) or at Cafe Church (next Sunday in St Ninian's) – cards available at both churches. Then they can start splashing around in His Love and Grace for themselves and others!

The New Life just keeps spreading!

Plastic Free - While governmental measures are extremely important and make a real impact, it has become clear that it is not enough to quickly turn the plastic tide. It is also down to all of us as individuals and communities to do our bit and look at ways we can help. So, **how to start living plastic free** – we hear you ask?

We all know this is a complex and broad subject, but we also know that the first step is half the journey! It is fair to say that removing plastic completely from our lives from one day to the next would be practically impossible, so the first tip towards a plastic free life is...take a reusable shopping bag when going shopping.

Can you help?

Dunscore with Moniaive / Glencairn Churches have been twinned with Lubuto, Ndola Zambia Church of Zambia Congregations for the past 14 years. There have been various visits back and forth during that time. It was decided that to refresh the twinning Lubuto congregation would be asked to send two delegates to Scotland.

Rev Friday Sinconde, minister and Mr Levy Mwanza were selected by the Lubuto congregation. A Faithshare grant was successfully applied for, where the Church of Scotland pay the airfares of the delegates.

The host churches have to cover their visa and insurance costs.

Subject to successfully obtaining visas, the two Zambians are coming to Dunscore and Moniaive *(Date to be announced)* and the visit will need volunteers to make it run smoothly. These include:

- Driving the Zambians to and from the airport,
- Hosting them for the duration of their visit (this would be in one week blocks) Hosting daily activities (which will include trips to the seaside, to local towns and hopefully to Edinburgh).
 - Providing them with an evening meal (we will need to provide this for each night of their stay).
