## **Eco-snippet**

Recycle as much as possible.

Make it easy for yourself by ensuring your recycling bins are easily accessible. Let's face it – if every time you want to access your recycling bins you have to open a hundred doors and walk a hundred miles to reach the back of your garden, you'll end up not recycling as much as you could.

A lot of councils only provide one big bin for each material – plastic, paper, metal, cardboard etc. – which realistically would never all fit in an average-sized kitchen. So the way to do this is: have small recycling containers or rigid bags in the kitchen (either under the sink or in a corner) and keep the bigger bins outside. This allows you to avoid having to leave the kitchen every time you want to recycle something. Once the containers in the kitchen are full, then you can make a trip to your recycling station outside.

# Can you help?

Dunscore with Moniaive / Glencairn Churches have been twinned with Lubuto, Ndola Zambia Church of Zambia Congregations for the past 14 years. There have been various visits back and forth during that time. It was decided that to refresh the twinning Lubuto congregation would be asked to send two delegates to Scotland.

Rev Friday Sinconde, minister and Mr Levy Mwanza were selected by the Lubuto congregation. A Faithshare grant was successfully applied for, where the Church of Scotland pay the airfares of the delegates.

The host churches have to cover their visa and insurance costs.

Subject to successfully obtaining visas, the two Zambians are coming to Dunscore and Moniaive (Date to be announced) and the visit will need volunteers to make it run smoothly. These include:

- Driving the Zambians to and from the airport,
- Hosting them for the duration of their visit (this would be in one week blocks)
   Hosting daily activities (which will include trips to the seaside, to local towns and hopefully to Edinburgh).
  - Providing them with an evening meal (we will need to provide this for each night of their stay).
