Eco-snippet For the on-going battles in the garden ...

Eco-Friendly Weed Killer

1 Litre White Vinegar.

3 Large Tbsp Salt.

3 Tsp Washing Up Liquid.

Spray-bottle.

Add salt to vinegar and once dissolved add washing up liquid, decant into spray-bottle and go.

Eco-Friendly Moss Killer

Sprinkle non-biological washing powder over the moss

Leave or if dry spell (ha!ha!) lightly water.
