A Message from our Minister:

Today we meet Jesus in the ordinary as we share bread and wine. We come together, not just because it is the fifth Sunday of July, but to remember Jesus and celebrate His love for us.

Communion can be an emotive subject, but it is the one 'rite' Jesus left us – His Last Supper, shared with His Disciples at a time of uncertainty and fear, yet to be repeated at all times whether ordinary or dramatic. Receiving bread and wine is not a result of being perfect, or a sign of membership, or a privilege for the few, but an admission that we need to meet Jesus and remember what He has done for us. However, we come – troubled by a crisis, plodding through life, enjoying quieter times – we pray that Jesus will be made real to us in the breaking of bread and sharing of wine.

Our reading today is part of Jesus' description of the Kingdom of God. He uses the ordinary to describe the extra-ordinary, the seemingly insignificant to show the infinite, the temporary to display the eternal. As is often the case, Jesus wants to challenge our view of how things should be and replace it with how God sees things.

Let's keep an eye out for God's Kingdom at work in the ordinary things of life. Then join in!

Eco-snippet

Can you spare any vodka? Eke out your vanilla ... it has travelled a long way!

Create your own vanilla extract! Take a dried vanilla pod and slice it open from top to bottom.

Place in a glass jar and cover with 150ml (or so) of vodka. Seal the jar and let it rest in a kitchen cupboard for 4-6months, turning or shaking the jar occasionally.

When you feel ready ... filter the homemade vanilla extract through an unbleached coffee filter (or cheesecloth) into a bottle. A great store cupboard essential or smashing gift!
