Eco-snippet Three ideas to reduce waste and save pennies...

Left-over coleslaw – no problem add to lasagne or other meals with white sauce.

Left-over potato salad – try roasting in a tray makes really tasty roast potatoes and freezes well.

Cheats mascarpone cheese – equal quantities of whipped double cream and full fat soft cream cheese mixed make a decent substitute for mascarpone. Add icing sugar to taste for sweet

version. Costs half the price of mascarpone cheese and freezes really well.
