A Message from our Minister:

One of the prayers I often use at funerals includes the line:

"Grant us, Lord, the wisdom and the grace to use aright the time that is left to us ..."

Remembrance reminded us to work for peace. Inter-faith week (just ending) has challenged us to work for true community (common unity). Today we are faced with God's judgement – how have we used what He has given us?

The prayer above gives a clue ... we need wisdom and grace. The wisdom to discern what we have been given, and who has given it to us. The grace to use those gifts boldly for God's purpose – the sharing of His Love. The word 'grace' also reminds us that we need God's help, whether we think we have a great gift or talent, or feel that our abilities are not up to much.
