ECO SNIPPET

Sustainable fish - When buying fish try alternatives to cod, haddock, salmon, tuna and prawns. Fish such as hake, char, dab or mackerel are just as good and often much cheaper. (A recent purchase of hake was £11/kg against £22/kg for more 'popular' fish.) Also use your fishmonger to fillet it for you ...win win! Check the Good Fish Guide [goodfishguide.org] for a wider range of sustainable alternatives.

Christmas Trees We have some unusual Christmas trees - they are sitka spruce and so are a bit on the jaggy side but very cheap at £20 and could be quite a talking point. The money will go to **Embrace the Middle East**. Their carbon footprint will be your fuel to pick it up or less if you can collect on foot or by bike! They are from 3 foot to 15 foot high.
