TECHNOLOGY: Descaling your washing machine - You don't need shop bought products to descale your washing machine Just use a large cup of white vinegar or lemon juice in place of your usual detergent and run the machine empty on a normal cycle!

FOOD: Banana news - Did you know that keeping your bananas in a bunch means that they will ripen at the same time, breaking up the bunch will prevent this. Also, by storing apples in a fruit bowl you can spoil the other fruit, so keep them separate from other fruits for a longer life...

Best before date conundrum - Food at its "best before" date, doesn't mean it's ready to be thrown away. Common sense methods include:-

Sight: Check if there is any mould, discoloration, or any signs of spoilage.

Smell: If the food has a nasty smell, it is likely off.

Touch: If the texture of the food is different to normal then it is most likely off.

N.B. Rules and guidelines apply to all types of food, including frozen or pantry food but it is personal choice as to whether something is OK to eat.
