Today we celebrate rainbows! and the promise they carry ... At **Dunscore** we hold a baptism for Maggie - a treasure to her family - and pray that she will walk with God through her life, just as much as she walks with her earthly family. We're told in Scripture that Noah "walked with God" (Gen 6:9b) and we all know how the story goes! Yet we can still learn from the familiar.
