A Message from our Minister:

March is here! And it starts with Prayer. A weekend of Prayer in Moniaive began on Friday when Christians from across the area gathered to share in the World Day of Prayer using material prepared by Palestinian Christian women reflecting their struggles in faith and daily life written before the October 2023 terrorist attacks and subsequent military action. The World Day of Prayer movement describes itself as "Informed Prayer, Prayerful Action" and raises funds for the needy areas highlighted - last year it was Taiwan.

This afternoon (Sunday 3rd) St Ninian's hosts 'Moniaive at Prayer: 'Prayer for Peace' where people of all faiths (and none) and all ages come together to pray for Peace in our world, in our community, in our lives. This has risen from a small multi-faith group who meet to pray regularly and follows on from last year's Remembrance event at the Institute. Join us if you can - there's tea and toast too!

ECO-Snippets - tips for working towards a more sustainable life ...

To prevent a skin developing on a half-used can of paint:
