### **Eco Snippet**

- 1. Seed pots: start saving your toilet roll middles ready for spring. Toilet paper rolls make excellent seed starters for plants that dislike root disturbance, as they can be planted directly into the soil without removing the plant from the roll. Good idea is to keep them in a storage container or even a plastic bag so that they don't get damp.
- 2. Plastic bottle cloches offer a practical and eco-friendly solution for protecting individual plants in a minigreenhouse setup. They are cost effective, versatile, improve airflow by adding top ventilation and are easy to transplant as the entire bottom of the bottle can go in the ground.

For example, did you know that in the 1920s the Kirk Session was still involved and recording when a child was born in "uncleanliness" and both the child's mother and the father were dealt with according to the law of the church. In 1958 there



was a lot of discussion about purchasing a car for the minister – consideration was given to a bubble car although these were felt to "not fall within the dignity of the appointment".
