A Message from our Minister:

Jesus liked to challenge people who thought they were OK! Often His teaching is aimed at His Disciples (who chose to walk with Him), the Pharisees (religious leaders of their day), and those who felt comfortable (the rich, influential, powerful). Today we think about three very real challenges – "love your enemies"!; "do unto others as you would have them do unto you."!; "be merciful as your Father in heaven is merciful"! In the words of the old sketch show ... "I'll get my coat!" We all spot hypocrisy a mile off, but do we sense it in ourselves? God sets the standard for Love, Mercy, Grace, and we can only aspire to it. In our own strength we cannot meet those standards of consistency and quickly fall into hypocrisy.
