A MESSAGE FROM OUR MINISTER:

As we rush through Lent, the Sundays become vital pit-stops for us. Not just because they are Holy Days and not Fast Days, but because they help us re-set for the week ahead. An opportunity to come before God, to meet with Him, to pray, to praise, to listen. An opportunity to be with others on the same journey of faith, those who struggle, those who doubt, those who are sad, lonely, isolated for the rest of the week.
