A Message from our Minister

I'm sure we've all spent many an hour searching for something that we've lost! It's frustrating and tiring. We've all known the joy of finding what was lost! It's exhilarating and rewarding. Those of a 'certain age' will remember the old Lost and Found desks at railway stations and bus depots – shelves and racks full of umbrellas, cases, coats, musical instruments, etc - waiting to be reclaimed by worried owners. That assumes that the owner misses the object or cares enough to make the effort required to ask for it back!

Today we'll hear about God's approach to what is lost. Like a shepherd down a sheep, a widow losing part of her dowry, a father missing an errant son.

We, all too often, see images of Search and Rescue teams digging through rubble, trekking to remote places, scanning the landscape for signs of those who are buried, lost or injured. They are seeking people they do not know personally but still put all their skills to use in the effort. It's heart-rending to see the lost recovered, the injured air-lifted, the trapped freed.

Communion reminds us of another dramatic rescue operation. God's ultimate plan to reach out to those who had turned away from Him. Not strangers, but the people He created to receive and respond to His Love. A plan aimed at everyone, regardless. Jesus' Death and Resurrection is the ultimate rescue mission – a spiritual mission of Mercy and Love for those who are lost.
