We will learn how God heals even lepers. Outcasts through their disease and the fear of it. Seen as unclean by the religious, a sign of God's displeasure with sinners.

Naaman was a foreigner. The ten lepers were from many different backgrounds.

This didn't stop God being able to work His healing on them. Naaman tried to show his gratitude by gifts of gold, but Elisha told him to show thankfulness by worshipping God. Nine lepers didn't show any gratitude (outwardly, at least) but one (a Samaritan) chose to return to Jesus and express his thanks personally. When did we last thank God for all He has done for us? Surely we should show our gratitude by living lives dedicated to Him and His Way, following the example of Jesus in our daily lives. Join us to seek healing or express thankfulness. God Bless.
