As we remember those who have gone before us – the Saints, those we knew, those we didn't know – we turn to God for comfort and strength.

In our services today we will think about how Jesus changed the life of Zaccheus, the tax-collector.

Zaccheus knew something was missing from His life. The money he fiddled from the system and from his neighbours didn't fill the gap. People around him turned away from him. He had nowhere to turn and no-one to turn to. Until ...

We all know the story. Tall crowds. Short man. Tall tree. Short scramble. Spotted. Called down. Hospitality required. Hospitality given. Life changed. Heart opened. Crowd amazed.

Like Zaccheus we can feel lost in times of grief, missing someone, knowing that there is a gap in our heart that needs filling. Zaccheus chose to find out what Jesus was up to. The man who wept for His friend Lazarus met Zaccheus' need, filled his heart, changed his outlook. He can do the same for us.
