A Message from our Minister

Today we read about the Transfiguration of Jesus. The time when His true inner self was revealed as disciples looked on. An amazing situation for Peter, James and John to witness. We will think about what that says about Jesus but also begin to reflect on what it can mean for us today. Lent begins this week (Wednesday) and is often used as a time for reflection, resolution and re-assessment for our lives. It is a reminder of the personal journey we are on ... the pilgrimage through life. A journey which involves our body, mind and soul. A journey that we hope will bring well-being, health and faith. A journey which can lead to transformation physically (beach body!?), mentally (mindfulness!?), and spiritually (openness to God!?). It is frightening to reveal our inner selves (or even to think of them), yet we need to open ourselves to what God has for us through Jesus, and allow the Holy Spirit to renew us, inside and out!
