A Message from our Minister

This week we hear a short reading. Yet it offers us a huge challenge. Are we showing Jesus in our lives so that others can recognise God at work and respond themselves?

Jesus describes a very close link and relationship between the Father, Jesus Himself, disciples who go out in His Name, and those who respond in the right spirit to their message and presence. This reminds us that we are not alone. The Holy Spirit dwells within us and is also at large around us in the world, preparing others by touching their inner spirits and stirring them to recognise God and their need of Him. As Jesus is made real to us, so we carry Him with us and others see Him too.

It has been said that we are the only Bible most people read ... can they see God in your life?

Eco-Snippet:

MAKE MORE OF YOUR GARDEN

These vegetables have edible flowers:

- **Rocket** (*Eruca vesicaria sativa*)
Rocket has spicy blossoms. Leaves taste bitter after plants bloom.
- **Radish** (*Raphanus sativus*)
Radish flowers are peppery.
- **Scarlet runner beans** (*Phaseolus vulgaris*)
Scarlet runner beans have mild-flavoured crunchy blossoms.
- **Squash** (*Cucurbita pepo*)
Squash flowers are mild-flavoured and sturdy enough to cook well.
Harvest male blossoms (those with slender stems, not set on the end of tiny fruits). If you pick female blossoms you won't get squash!
