ECO SNIPPET:

In the garden, collect rainwater in butts or other containers. Save grey water (shower, bath & kitchen water) for watering the garden (but use within 24hrs).

Water the garden early morning or late evening to minimise evaporation. Mulching flower & vegetable beds can reduce evaporation by up to 75%.
